**A \$3,000.00 deposit is required on all traditional funerals (unless prepaid); all Direct Dispositions must be paid in full at the time of the arrangements.**

Payment

- Payment is due within 30 days of the funeral. Payment may be made by cash, cheque, most major credit cards, and debit. Beyond the allotted time, interest will be charged at a rate of 1%, which is equivalent to 12% per annum.

Prepaying Funding

- For your convenience, when prepaying, you pay for the services and supplies today and the funds will be placed in trust, where it will accrue interest until the contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered) or the contract

## Disbursements

- Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by us. You are expected to pay for these items at the time the contract is entered into. The following are some items that are often identified as disbursements.
- **Coroner's fee** – this is a fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place. The Chief Coroner for Ontario sets this fee.
- **Cremation fee** – this is the fee that the crematorium charges for the cremation to occur.
- **Clergy honorarium** – this is an amount paid to the clergy or the church for their services. In some cases the amount is established by the clergy or the church.
- **Organist / Soloist / Piper** - this is an amount paid to the Organist / Soloist / Piper for their services at the church, in our chapel, or at the cemetery (Piper).
- **Municipal death registration fee** – this is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death. The fee is set by the municipality and may vary.

Last Post Fund: Funerals are available to veterans who require assistance;

Social Services: Families who feel that they are not financially able to pay for a funeral should contact Social Services. This **MUST** be done before funeral arrangements can be made. If your application is not approved by Social Services, you'll be requested to pay the account in full at the time of the arrangements.

## **FUNERAL SERVICES PRICE LIST**

The prices set out in this schedule are effective from the date shown on the price list and are subject to change without notice. This list does not include prices for newspaper notices. Flower cars, limousines, mileage, overtime charges, long distance calls or other items, and services will be added onto our final account to the purchaser.

## PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

### **Coordinating activities, rites, ceremonies**

- Professional consultation with licensed Funeral director, including, but not limited to, expert advice on options to meet your needs.
- Co-ordination of all activities, rites and ceremonies, before, during and after they have been provided, including services and supplies provided by us, as well as those provided by third party suppliers, such as caskets and death notices.
- Licensing Fees are included.

## DOCUMENTATION

### **Permits, forms, etc.**

- Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to, burial permit, coroner's certificate for cremation, documentation necessary to ship the body out of the country.
- Provision of 10 Proofs of Death issued by Paul O'Connor Funeral Home (our proofs of death are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes, but sometimes a provincial "Death Certificate" will be necessary and is available from the Office of the Registrar General).

## FACILITIES

### **Basic:**

- Use of our facilities, including parking area, areas open to the public within our funeral home, our arrangement office, casket display room, and other facilities and equipment required to operate as a licensed funeral home.
- Facilities used to prepare, embalm and shelter the body.

### **Facilities for Visitation** (requires Staff Services for Visitation)

- Designated facilities used for visitation for a period of up to 4 hours, a supplement cost for any additional hour(s) requested above the 4 hours.
- Use of any or all of the following: register and donation card stand, casket bier, flower stands, sound equipment and any religious equipment.

### **Facilities for Funeral** (requires Staff Services for Funeral)

- Designated facilities used for the ceremony or memorial service in our chapel for up to one hour.
- Set up in our chapel, home or church.
- This may include any or all of the following: lectern, organ, sound equipment, religious equipment, flower stands, register and donation card stands, casket bier, casket carriage, etc..

## STAFF SERVICES

### **One Period of Visiting:**

- Staff to coordinate and oversee the visitation (informal gathering) for a period up to four hours.
- Set up for visitation off premises
- Receiving and arranging floral tributes, co-coordinating other duties associated with visitation exclusive of any rites and or services.

### **Staff Services for Funeral**

- Staff to coordinate and oversee the ceremony or memorial service in our chapel for up to one hour.
- Set up in our chapel, home or church.
- Staff to coordinate and oversee the ceremony or memorial service in a place of worship for up to three hours, anything over this allotted time will result in Overtime for the Director and the lead car.  
Co-coordinating of other duties associated with the funeral rites and services

## **EMBALMING**

- Embalming is the process of replacing bodily fluids with chemical preservatives. It is a process of sanitation, restoration and temporary preservation. Embalming is not legally required, but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and the visitation or disposition of the deceased. Our professional funeral directors will make a recommendation based on the condition of the body and expected service needs.
- Funerals with viewing, or the holding of a body for a period of time in excess of 48 hours between death and final disposition, requires embalming by funeral home policy.
- Winter storage involved, with a spring interment to follow, embalming will be required.

## **Other Body Preparation**

- The preparation of the body for placement into the casket or container.
- Including dressing.
- Hairdresser and cosmetology.

## **AUTOMOTIVE EQUIPMENT**

- Transfer remains – initial or additional (within Toronto area, additional Km fees apply beyond 416 area code). Our service van is used for these services.
- Transportation of the remains from one place to another, for example the hospital to the funeral home, or from the funeral home to the cemetery or crematorium, a charge applies for each transport request.
- Receiving remains at an airport / train station.

### **Lead / Clergy Vehicle**

- Vehicle may include any or all of the following uses: - Leading the funeral procession. Transportation of clergy to the funeral home, places of funeral rite and to the place of final disposition.

### **Funeral Coach**

- The use of this vehicle on a single occasion.
- Transportation of the deceased from our facility to the place of the funeral rite and to the place of final disposition within a three-hour limit.
